The notice also mentioned they'll be making their ENTIRE ARCHIVE available...to people who subscribe. Again, old articles are gathering dust on library shelves and anyone can check them out for free. Now the NYT can cleverly leverage that remarkable database and GET MORE READERS to come to its website and make money off that increased traffic via web ads. They make virtually NOTHING off those articles that are decades old but imagine how often they could link to them from current articles or simply make them available and watch bloggers and students and the curious explore that database and get exposed to ads again and again and again. How shortsighted and stupid can the Grey Lady be? Very stupid, apparently.
