White House Ignores 9-11 Group

Goss, the C.I.A. director; Robert S. Mueller III, the F.B.I. director, and Andrew H. Card Jr., the White House chief of staff, among others.

That's right. Bush can't even be bothered to say a polite "no." He's just closing his eyes and ears and pretending they don't even exist.
