Simon and the gay Idols

WILL YOUNG—WHO WON THE U.K. Pop Idol contest and then promptly came out—is finally hitting America! Sort of. The tall, lanky, good-looking Young is featured in a music video on the 101 Dalmatians II: Patch's London Adventure DVD, swinging the big band number "Try Again."

Unfortunately, Young's other attempts to gain a toehold in the U.S. market are failing. When impresario Simon Cowell—Mr. Nasty in the smash hit spin-off American Idol—was asked about Young's debut album ever getting released in the States, he said, "Unlikely. Unlikely.
